After 73 years in operation, this 206-bed skilled nursing facility is still providing quality nursing care. That includes its specialty services of physical, occupational and speech therapy, in addition to long-term nursing care, and hospice care.

In response to the ongoing coronavirus pandemic, Sadie G. Mays has implemented many enhanced infection control protocols. These include: temperature screening staff and patients daily; requiring all staff to wear full Personal Protective Equipment (PPE); frequent cleaning and sanitizing the entire facility; periodic testing, ceasing visitation, and more. The organization continues to follow the latest guidelines from public health officials for the safety of its patients and staff.

Understanding that communication is key to our residents' emotional well-being, we have instituted a new *Video Chat* program through our management company, PruittHealth. Family members may schedule calls throughout the week to see and speak with their loved ones. The medical team at Sadie G. Mays is doing everything possible to be responsive and keep families abreast of the condition of their loved ones.
